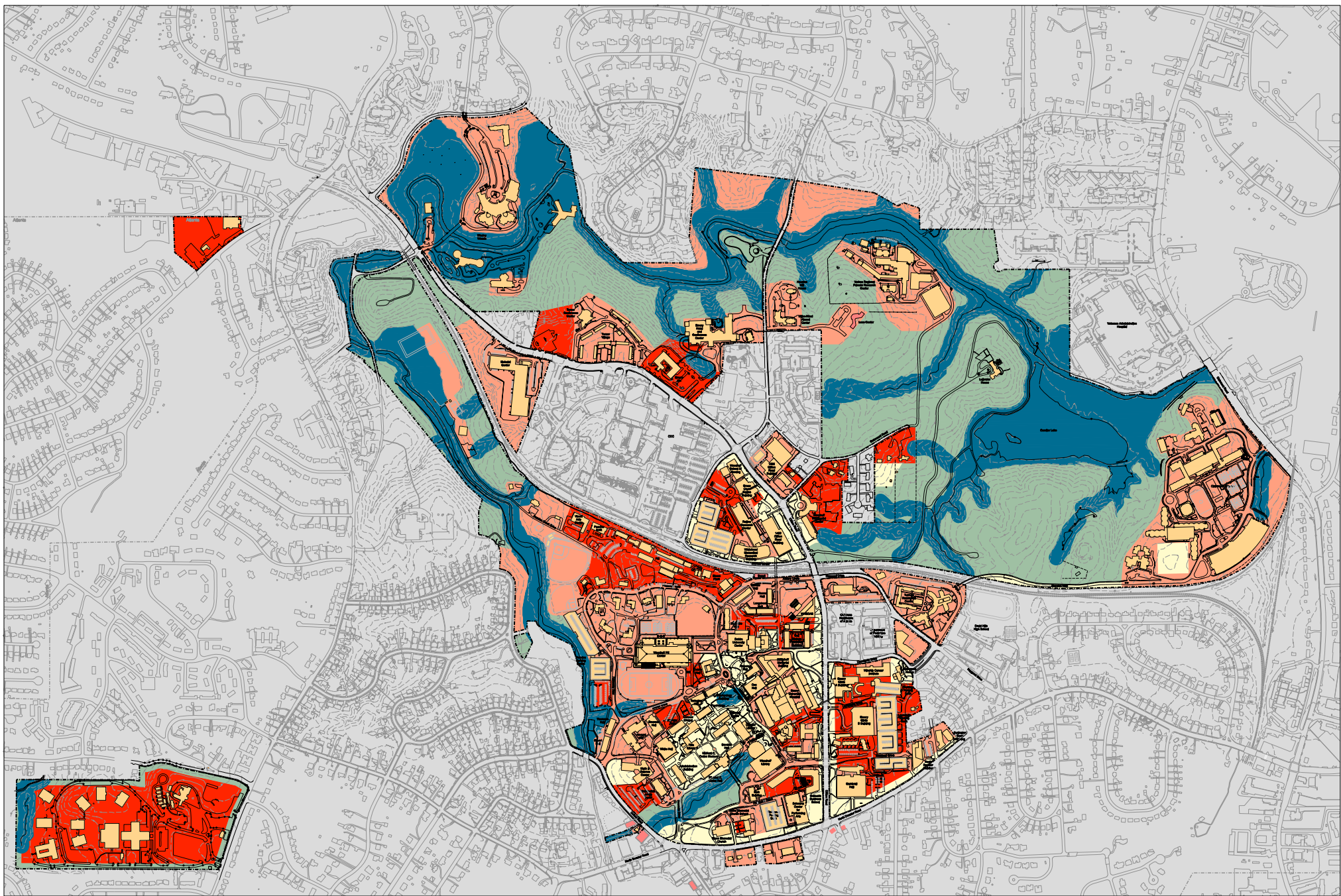




RESTRICTED LAND
28% OF LAND AREA

CLASSIFICATION DEMOTES AREAS SUCH AS STREAM BUFFERS AND FLOODPLAINS THAT BY LAW, ORDINANCE, OR COVENANT IS RESTRICTED FROM CAPITAL DEVELOPMENT.

PRESERVED LAND
23% OF LAND AREA

LAND THAT SHOULD NOT BE DEVELOPED DUE TO UNIQUE ECOLOGICAL VALUE.

CONSERVED LAND
9% OF LAND AREA

LAND VALUED FOR ITS UNIQUE CULTURAL HISTORY AND WHICH FORMS PART OF THE CAMPUS IDENTITY. LAND USE FROM A LAND USE PERSPECTIVE THAT CLASSIFICATION HAS BEEN DEVELOPED TO CAPACITY. LAND SHOULD BE DEVELOPED TO EXTREMELY RESTRICTIVE PROTOCOLS.

MANAGED LAND
31% OF LAND AREA

LAND THAT CAN ACCOMMODATE LIMITED REDEVELOPMENT. RESTORATION OF THESE SITES WILL REQUIRE RESTORATION OF UNDERSTANDING AND PROVIDE OPPORTUNITIES FOR ENHANCEMENT OF STORM WATER FLOWS.

DEVELOPABLE LAND
14% OF LAND AREA

LAND PRESERVED FOR REDEVELOPMENT/REDEVELOPMENT. THE SITES WILL MEET UNIVERSITY-LEAS REQUIREMENTS AND PROVIDE OPPORTUNITIES FOR ENHANCEMENT OF THE CAMPUS LANDSCAPE ENVIRONMENT.
